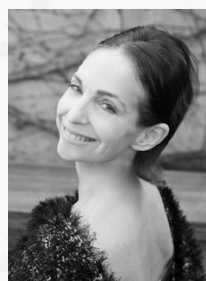

As a principal dancer of the New York City Ballet Stephanie performed leading roles with Baryshnikov in Balanchine's Apollo, as Giselle with Alexander Godunov, and with Nureyev and Friends on Broadway. Stephanie's classes reflect her long performing career and integrate information derived from having worked one-on-one with Balanchine, Robbins, and colleagues.

Elena Malashevskaya represents the training and schooling of the Saint Petersburg ballet tradition.
